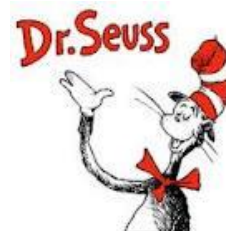

Classroom St. Patrick's Day parties will be Tuesday March 17th during afternoon snack. Sign up sheets will be posted outside classroom doors.

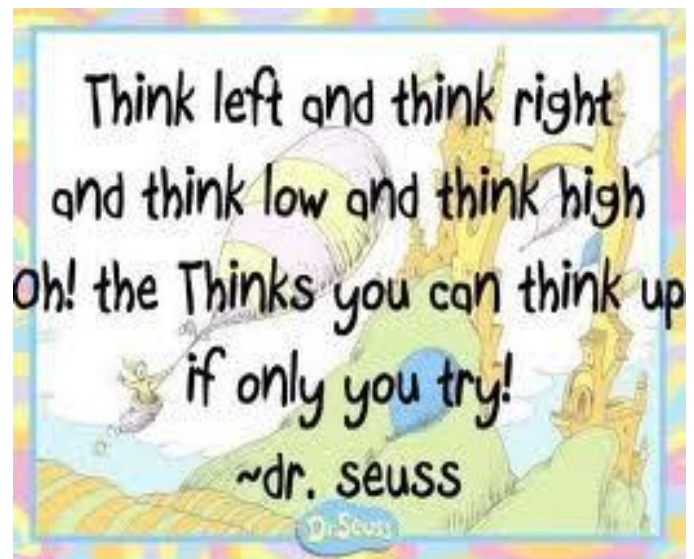
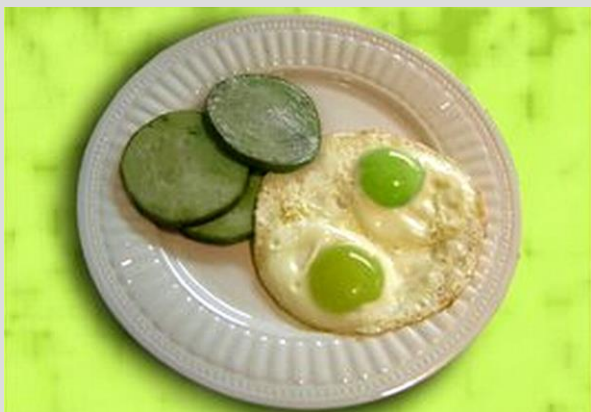
Green Eggs and Ham

- 1 tbsp diced ham

Directions:

1. Crack egg into small bowl
2. Add diced ham
3. Add milk and blue food coloring
4. Pour into preheated greased skillet
5. Whisk together
6. Scramble eggs
7. Serve with toast and orange juice
